


## D'Aguilar Range

## Mount Mee

### 16 The Gantry

Travel, on a sealed road, for 150m from the park entrance to The Gantry; the closest Mount Mee picnic area to Brisbane. The Gantry shelter is a legacy of the sawmill that operated here until 1981. Stop for a picnic or barbecue at this grassy picnic area.

### 17 Picabeen walk

1km circuit. Allow 30 minutes.

This short walk takes you along a boardwalk and track through a grove of picabeen palms. Signs provide information about the different forest types and timber-getting history of the area.

### 18 Somerset trail

13km circuit. Allow 3–4 hours.

Beginning at The Gantry, this track passes through scribbly gum forests, rainforest and dry open forest. About halfway along, take in views to the west, overlooking Lake Somerset and Lake Wivenhoe. Parking available at The Gantry carpark.

### 19 Somerset Lookout

Enjoy spectacular views to the west over the Great Dividing Range, Lake Somerset and Wivenhoe's headwaters. Access to this lookout is by four-wheel-drive vehicle only or by walking along the Somerset trail.

### 20 Falls Lookout

1.4km circuit. Allow 40 minutes.

Falls Lookout can be reached by a gravel road (accessible by two-wheel-drive vehicles) and has a short walk down to a viewing platform overlooking the northern side of D'Aguilar Range and the picturesque Neurum Valley.

### 21 Mill rainforest walk

1.4km circuit. Allow 40 minutes.

Winding through subtropical rainforest this track provides great opportunities for birdwatching, so take your binoculars. The track entrance can be accessed by a gravel road, which is accessible by two-wheel-drive vehicles.

### 22 Rocky Hole

(See main map) zoom return. Allow 20 minutes.

Surrounded by dry open sclerophyll forest, this site features a rock pool and is popular during summer. Access is on gravel road and suitable for two-wheel-drive vehicles.

**⚠ For your safety do not jump or dive into the water hole.**

### 23 Neurum Creek camping area

### 24 Lophostemon walk

750m circuit. Allow 10 minutes.

Take a leisurely stroll through tall open eucalypt forest with a rainforest understorey. This circuit begins at the northern end of the camping area.

### 25 Broadwater

(See main map)

Broadwater is a popular spot during the hot summer months. Enjoy a picnic or barbecue lunch at this small picnic area adjacent to a large waterhole. From The Gantry, Broadwater is only accessible by four-wheel-drive vehicles. It can be accessed by two-wheel-drive vehicles from the north via Woodford.

**⚠ For your safety do not jump or dive into the water hole.**

### 26 Archer camping area

(See main map)

Enjoy the natural bush setting near Neurum Creek. From The Gantry, Archer camping area is only accessible by four-wheel-drive vehicles. It can be accessed by two-wheel-drive vehicles from the north via Woodford. Facilities are provided for campers only. Generators are prohibited. This camping area is not suitable for caravans or trailers. You will need to obtain a camping permit prior to arrival.
